Indigenous student of the Laklãnõ-Xokleng people, graduated in "Intercultural Teacher Training Degree of South of the Atlantic Forest of Brazil", 2014. Medical student in the Federal University of Santa Catarina since 2016.

In 2014 took over the culture coordination of the "Vanhecu Patte Indian School" in the Indigenous Land Ibirama Laklãnõ, where he transcribed traditional songs of his people and taught them to the students of the school. While in the Indian School also worked as a voluntary to teach environment education to the indian children to make the vegetable garden inside a agroforest dynamics.

As a medical student in 2016, he participated as a speaker at the "DesMedicalização congress" in the USP (University of Sao Paulo). He is the author of the article The Healing of the Soul in the Context of Xokleng Laklãnõ (A cura da alma no contexto Xokleng Laklãnõ), where he is in the process of publishing the journal Makro-jê. Author of the article, The healing through the Xondaro ancestral dance (A cura através da dança ancestral Xondaro) contextualizing with the Neuroscience, Anatomy and Physiology, 2016.

In 2017 was awarded by the Catarinense Foundation of Culture with project "Tata Kusüg Goj in the Paths of the Sacred Land" (Tata Kusüg Goj - Nos caminhos da terra sagrada).
